Unmute – If you were a Christmas decoration, what would you be? Why?






On left side of screen is a red button (leave), by that is 'switch camera' and 'switch to gallery view'/'Switch to active speaker' button.






Go to gallery view - **double tap** to pin. Double tap to remove.




















- Iouch up my appearance




